Sunday was another wet day, when prudence would have dictated my staying home, but it was Sacrament Sunday, tho Mama Sister could not go I thought it proper to attend. I remained home afterwards, but at night had a smart Fever, which with my cold so stupified me yest that I c d do little more than discharge the duties of my...
