In the largest outlier, at South Cove, there was an instructive section at the southern end, in the large clay-pit, marked on the map, a little southward of South Cove church, the eastern part only of which was clear in 1879. This apparently cuts across an old and shallower pit, for the top part looks as if it had been filled in to some extent. Buff and pale-grey sandy Boulder Clay, from 9 to 18 feet thick, rests irregularly on, and makes plunges into, sand. The clay is mostly bedded, the lower part particularly, with thin layers of fine buff sand, expanding in places to lenticular masses up to 2 feet in thickness. It weathers irregularly into a stony loam at the top; and still more, where the pit touches the road...
